Electronic Payments

P.A.D & DEBIT

Starting August 1, 2016 the Town office will be accepting Pre Authorized Debit (PAD) and accepting debit cards for payments. We also accept online payments for utilities and taxes from CIBC and Affinity Credit Union.

Compost Effective June 28, 2016 the Town will no longer offer pick up of compost. Compost is accepted at no charge at the Transfer Station during regular operating hours.
