CURBSIDE ROLLING OUT THIS SUMMER



The Town will be officially making the move to residential curbside garbage pickup this summer (anticipated in May/June). Watch your mail for details as we get closer to implementing the new program. The cost of curbside service will be included in the mill rate for taxes as a core service.

REACT will make a presentation at the Town Hall Meeting on April 28th.

The bins are a good size so we will start with garbage pickup every two weeks.

At this time, due to the fact that we have the community recycle bins which are well used, we won't be doing curbside recycling. We can reassess curbside recycling once the market for recycled plastics and glass improves.

PROPERTY ASSESSMENT FAQ

SAMA (Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency) was recently in Naicam to complete their annual maintenance on our property assessments.

Once we have their report back, those with a change to their assessment will receive an assessment notice and the assessment roll will open. While the roll is open (for 30 days) any property owner can appeal their assessment. There is a fee to appeal of \$50 per residential property and \$150 for commercial/industrial.

What if I feel my assessment is incorrect?

If you feel your assessment is in error you can appeal it if you have sufficient grounds for the appeal. For example perhaps SAMA has rated the condition of your property 'average', but you feel it is in 'poor' condition, or they have assessed a deck on your property in 2002 and the deck has since been removed.
