Water Treatment Plant Upgrades

As most residents are aware our Public Works staff have been hard at work these last months keeping things up and running under trying circumstances until a permanent solution could be found for the troubles with our distribution pump system. At the January 22, 2020 Special Meeting of Council a proposal from Acadia Construction / Integrated Engineering was approved to replace our entire distribution pumping system.

Work will begin this spring from roughly May - August 2020. The cost of the upgrade will be in the neighbourhood of \$400,000 which will be funded by the Water & Sewer Reserves.

NEW WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Our water treatment plan is nearing the end of its life span and an entirely new plant will be needed within the next 10 years. A funding application to the federal government's infrastructure grant program (ICIP) will be submitted this year for this future planned project.

NAICAM GOLF COURSE UPDATE

We would like to thank the 104 respondents who answered the community survey regarding the Naicam Golf Course. Council has officially committed to keeping the course open and operating for another year. They will review what that is going to look like in regards to rates and fees, operations and upgrades, etc. at their February 25, 2020 meeting.

Centennial Flag: Council has approved the NDCC to run an official centennial flag contest as a way to help promote and celebrate Naicam's 100th birthday in 2021. Watch for announcements from the NDCC.

CURBSIDE PICKUP

Council has approved the move to residential bins with curbside pickup for garbage through REACT. This will replace the tag-a-bag system. Service will be front street year-round. This will be a core service that is now included with your residential taxes.

The program will not be rolled out until this May/June and REACT will be present at the Town Hall meeting on April 28th to review the program and answer questions. Residents will also see notices in their mailboxes and with water bills this spring as we get closer to starting the program.
