

TOWN OF NAICAM

BYLAW NO. 15/97

A BYLAW OF THE OF THE TOWN OF NAICAM IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO AUTHORIZE AMENDMENTS TO BYLAW NO. 15/86, BEING A BYLAW RESPECTING FIRE PREVENTION.

The Council of the Town of Naicam in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That paragraph 3 of Section 2 General Precautions Against Fire as set out in Bylaw No. 15/86 be deleted and the following paragraphs substituted therefor:
 - 3.a) No person shall cause or permit to caused the open burning of trash, refuse, garbage, industrial waste or any other material or waste in an open fire or an incinerator in a manner that causes air pollution within the boundaries of the Town of Naicam.
 - 3.b) The users and users as listed hereunder are exempt from the provision of paragraph 3(a) as set out in this Bylaw:
 - i. Factory Made Barbecues & Outdoor Fireplaces
 - ii. Homemade Barbecues and Outdoors Fireplaces
2. That paragraph 6 of Section 3 stoves, furnaces, etc., be added to provide for the following:
 6. The regulations applicable to a backyard outdoor fireplace are as follows:
 1. All factory made barbecues and outdoor fireplaces must be ULC tested and have a certified stamp.
 11. All homemade barbecues and outdoor fireplaces must be constructed of material such as cement, brick or metal of at least 18 gauge and covered with a heavy gauge metal screen with openings no larger than 13mm(1/2").
 111. Size of the fire box of an outdoor fireplace or barbecue shall not exceed 1000 square inches.
 - 1V. All Constructed outdoor fireplaces and barbecues must be built in the rear yard. This regulation does not apply to natural gas or propane appliances.
 - V. The fuel for backyard outdoor fireplaces and barbecues shall consist of seasoned wood or charcoal only. The burning of the following material is prohibited:
 - a) rubber products of any kind
 - b) plastic
 - c) manure
 - d) garden refuse
 - e) livestock or animal carcasses
 - f) asphalt roofing products
 - g) creosoted wood or any similar material

- h) hydrocarbons
- i) insulation from electrical coring or equipment
- j) any material which burned will generate a foul odour or black smoke
- k) any material classified as a dangerous good

V1. Fire in backyard outdoor barbecues or fireplaces must be reasonably supervised so as to prevent their spread.

V11. All open areas on the appliance shall be screened to prevent sparks.

V111. Fires must not be set in windy conditions conducive to creating a running fire or a nuisance to another person.

1X. If smoke from an open air fire causes an unreasonable interference with the use and the enjoyment of another's property, the fire must be extinguished immediately.


X. The owner of such appliances prior to disposing of the ashes shall ensure that the ashes are completely dead.

X1. Construction of these appliances must be inspected by the Fire Department.

4. This Bylaw shall come into full force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.


