

BYLAW NO. 96

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF NAICAM WITH RESPECT TO
LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY

The Council of the Town of Naicam of the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:-

1. No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the town, as outlined in sections 2 and 3 of this Bylaw.
2. No person shall graze any cattle, nor shall any cattle be permitted to graze at any time within the area bounded by Boundary Street and the Northern Corporate limits of the town and Highway No. Six and the most easterly boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway right of way.
3. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time ~~within~~ the area bounded by Boundary Street and the Northern Corporate limits of the town and Highway No. Six and the most easterly boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway right of way.
4. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time beyond the area designated in Section 3 hereof except within a barn, shed, or poultry pen especially erected for such purpose and approved by the Town council.
5. The penalty for violation of any section of this bylaw shall ~~range from a minimum of~~ TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) to a maximum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)

READ a first time this seventh day of July A.D. 1964

READ a second time this seventh day of July A.D. 1964

READ a third time this seventh day of July A.D. 1964 and carried by unanimous vote of all members of Council present.


